Pohick Bay Park/ CBC Dad & Kids' Campout Rules

- 1. Tents are required. RVs of any form are not allowed; sleeping in a car or truck is prohibited.
- 2. Tent sites cannot be trenched, dug, or leveled.
- 3. No pets.
- 4. No alcoholic beverages.
- **5.** Park vehicles in designated parking areas only; do not park on the grassy areas.
- 6. **Dads are to be with their kids at all times**; children are not to go *anywhere* alone. Children need a "buddy" at all times.
- 7. Please respect park property and plants, and exhibit appropriate public behavior. All campers are expected to keep noise to a minimum. **Quiet hours are 10:00pm to 7:00am.**
- 8. Children are not allowed inside the amphitheater bonfire ring.
- 9. Site campfires are to be kept in the fire rings and monitored consistently.
- 10. We are not allowed to collect, cut or break logs and branches alive, dead or even on the ground. Bundled firewood is available at the camp store (\$6.99/bundle before tax) or at a nearby convenience store. To prevent the spread of destructive insects, only wood sourced IN FAIRFAX COUNTY can be brought.
- 11. Keep campsites neat and clean at all times.

- 12. To discourage animals near or in the campground, do not leave food or trash unattended. At departure, take trash to receptacles provided.
- 13. The nearby Comfort Station has bathroom and shower facilities.
- 14. Dishwater should be disposed in the designated sink at the Comfort Station.

Directions to Pohick from Centreville (allow about 40 minutes)

- GPS or app, enter: CAMP WILSON, Pohick Bay Regional Park, Lorton, VA, 22079
- Directions:
 - Take I-66 East to Fairfax County Parkway South. Drive for about 11 miles to the Hooes Road (Rt. 636 S) / Pohick Road exit. Turn right onto Hooes Road, then after about a mile, turn left onto Silverbrook Road. After about two miles, turn left onto Lorton Road, and then right onto Lorton Market Street. Go straight across Richmond Highway (Rt. 1), where it becomes Gunston Road. Then after about 3 miles turn left onto Woodrow Wilson Scout Reservation Road (dirt road). This is an unmarked dirt road with stone pillars flanking its entrance. It's on the left BEFORE a fire station. (If you arrive at the main entrance for Pohick Bay Regional Park, you've gone too far.)
 - Turn left onto the dirt road, entering Camp Wilson Pohick Bay Park's
 Youth/Group Camping Area. Drive slowly, passing an open field on the right and
 you'll see the Comfort Station on the left. Look for our campsites in areas A4 and
 C (see map below,) and fellow CBCer's!
