At Centreville Baptist Church, we consider our Community Groups our primary vehicle for cultivating spiritual growth and vitality.

Campus Community Groups	Home Community Groups
<p>Groups of 15 to 60 are <i>neighborhoods</i> within the church landscape. Midsize groups are designed to provide a warm and casual atmosphere as they function relationally more like adult “youth groups.” Due to the convenience of meeting primarily on Sunday mornings and being a larger size they are easy to check out.</p>	<p>Groups of 5 to 14 are <i>cul-de-sacs</i> within the church landscape. These groups meet weekly or bi-weekly in homes and are designed to develop deeper friendships as they can function relationally more like “extended family.” Groups can choose to be open groups accepting new members, or they can be closed groups due to space issues or other purposes.</p>
<p>Gender-based men’s & women’s groups of a variety of sizes and purposes meet on campus, in homes, & restaurants, etc.</p>

WHY groups?

In larger churches like ours, community groups are crucial to ministry that touches every person. We can never have enough Staff and Elders to meet all the individual needs in the church family. God never intended for it to be that way! So a key goal at CBC is to grow smaller through a growing network of **campus** and **home** community groups that connect people in caring Christ-centered relationships.

Groups are committed to a three-fold focus of shepherding group members toward *Connecting with God* (personal transformation/Christ-likeness), *Connecting with Others* (caring, meaningful relationships), and as a result, *Connecting with the World* (individually & as a group, embracing outreach causes, projects and/or partnerships)... all to fulfill our purpose to glorify God by making fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ.

HOW are these campus groups organized?

Each group has a name (i.e. Relevance, Be One) and takes on its own unique identity. Groups are led by a team that includes a **Community Leader** who oversees a leadership team of 4-6 people that organizes the group ministry. The **Teaching Coordinator** oversees the teaching ministry, and there are other team positions for **care** needs, **socials**, **admin** tasks, **outreach**/serving projects, etc.

WHAT are group meetings like?

Groups are unique, but common elements of group meetings include a fellowship time with coffee and treats, testimonies, sharing/prayer, and then a Bible study, all in an informal and relational setting that often involves lots of laughter! Several groups incorporate regular small group breakouts to build deeper relationships.

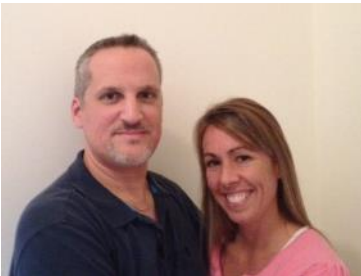

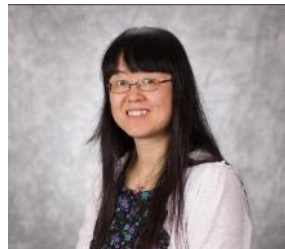
